During your visit you will learn about the rich and colorful history of the still-active Marquette Iron Range and see the massive iron ore docks that grace Marquette’s two deep water harbors. You will also visit the wonderful Michigan Iron Industry Museum which traces the story of iron mining in Michigan and its impact on the nation and the people and communities of Michigan’s Upper Peninsula.

The package also includes a historic City of Marquette Sightseeing Tour that features Marquette’s Historic Home and Harbor District, shopping in downtown Marquette, Presque Isle Park and over 7 miles of scenic Lake Superior shoreline.
