Day One **Arrive Marquette Country/Dinner at the elegant Landmark Inn**

Afternoon Arrive Marquette Country in Michigan's Upper Peninsula
Welcoming reception and check in at Marquette area lodging facility

Evening Rest and relaxation at Marquette area lodging facility
Travel to the Landmark Inn in downtown Marquette
Dinner off limited menu at the Skyroom Restaurant on the top floor of the Landmark Inn overlooking Lake Superior and downtown Marquette
Tour the historic Landmark Inn including 4 or 5 of the nicest available rooms
Return to Marquette area lodging facility for the evening
Rest and relaxation at Marquette area lodging facility

Day Two **Huron Mountains Wilderness Hiking Tour/Lunch in Big Bay**

Morning Breakfast at Marquette area lodging facility
(Meet Fred Huffman from Marquette Country Tours in hotel lobby)
Travel to the parking area at the foot of Sugarloaf Mountain
Hike trail to the top of Sugarloaf Mountain
Enjoy the view of Lake Superior and the surrounding countryside from the top
Hike down the backside of Sugarloaf Mountain to Wetmore's Landing
Hike the beach area along Lake Superior to the point just north of the Landing
Enjoy the view of Lake Superior and Sugarloaf Mountain from the point
Hike to the parking area at Wetmore's Landing
Board motorcoach at parking area /Rest stop at parking area vault toilet
Travel to the historic Thunder Bay Inn in Big Bay

Afternoon Light buffet lunch and tour at the Thunder Bay Inn in Big Bay
Big Bay window tour to include Squaw Beach, Perkins Park and the infamous Lumberjack Tavern
Travel to the trailhead parking area for Gobbler's Knob Scenic Overlook
Hike to the top of Gobbler's Knob
Enjoy the view of Big Bay and the surrounding countryside from the top
Return to the trailhead parking area for Gobbler's Knob
Travel to the Yellow Dog River trailhead on County Road 510
Hike into see Hills Falls on the Yellow Dog River
Enjoy the view of Hills Falls and time permitting continue downstream to see ancient glacial boulders and 2 or 3 other waterfalls)
Return to the trailhead parking area on County Road 510

Travel via County Road 510 to the trailhead parking area for Big Pup Creek Falls
Take the short hike into see Big Pup Creek Falls
Return to the trailhead parking area on Country Road 510
Travel to Marquette area lodging facility via County Road 510 and US-41

Evening Rest and relaxation at Marquette area lodging facility
Travel to the Casa Calabria Italian Restaurant in the Village in Marquette
Dinner off limited menu at the Casa Calabria Restaurant
Presque Isle Park Sunset Celebration Tour
(Seasonal activity depending on sunset time)
Return to Marquette area lodging facility for the evening
(Say good bye to Fred Huffman for the evening)
Rest and relaxation at Marquette area lodging facility

Day Three Forestville Falls Hike/Historic Marquette Lighthouse Tour

Morning Breakfast at Marquette area lodging facility
(Meet Fred Huffman from Marquette Country Tours in hotel lobby)
Travel to the Reany Creek trailhead in Forestville
Take the short hike into see the waterfalls on Reany Creek
Travel to the Dead River Falls trailhead
Hike into see 5 or 6 waterfalls on the Dead River
Travel to the Upfront & Company in downtown Marquette

Afternoon Lunch off limited menu at Upfront & Company (1/2 or full sandwich with cup or bowl of homemade soup & beverage, chips, pickle and dessert)
Travel to the Marquette Maritime Museum on the waterfront in Marquette
Tour the Marquette Maritime Museum and historic Marquette Lighthouse
Travel to downtown Marquette
Shopping and sightseeing on own in downtown Marquette
