Featured attractions include the Glass Bottom Boat Shipwreck Tour, the Marquette Maritime Museum and the historic Marquette Lighthouse

During your tour, you will learn about the rich and exciting maritime history of the Great Lakes at the Marquette Maritime Museum and see one of the largest collections of Fresnel lens on the Great Lakes. You will also view shipwrecks from a period long ago through space age glass wells on the Glass Bottom Boat Tour and tour the historic Marquette Harbor Lighthouse – one of the oldest and most photographed lighthouses on Lake Superior.

Last but not least, you will get the chance to see the massive iron ore docks that grace Marquette’s two deep water harbors, visit Presque Isle Park – the finest “natural” city park in the world and see Wagner and Munising Falls - two of the most beautiful and accessible waterfalls in Michigan’s Upper Peninsula.
